Millions of born-again, Spirit-filled believers who have been trained and equipped will prophetically speak the words of Jesus and apostolically demonstrate His miraculous power as witnesses of the Kingdom of God.

THE GREATEST CALLING

The greatest calling in Heaven or Earth is to be a Saint of the Highest God.

(Daniel 7:18, 27; Rom. 8:17; Eph. 1:18-20; 2:19).

Jesus told the multitudes who listened to His teaching that among those born of woman there had not anyone arise greater than John the Baptist. Then he added that the least Saint in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than he (Matt. 11:11).

The apostle Paul wrote to the Saints at Ephesus that he was praying for them:

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what is the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us, the ones believing according to the working of His mighty strength.

Ephesians 1:17-19

The Saints of God are those who have been given the privileged opportunity to be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ. This means not only the conforming of our inward character, attitudes, and desires, but also becoming like Jesus in all our behaviour and interactions with those around us. It includes being empowered by the Holy Spirit to operate in power and miracles to bring God's Kingdom to this earth.

The corporate body of the saints – the church

As a corporate group, the Saints, these redeemed people who are called out from the world, separated and dedicated unto God, are called Ecclesia, translated as “the Church.” Other corporate names are *the Body of Christ, God’s building, Christ’s Bride*, etc. The apostle Paul declared that there is only one Body of Christ on Earth, yet it has many members with various and diverse functions.

The ministry of all believers

- The Day of the Saints will bring revelation of truths:

... That is as revolutionary as some of the major truths of the Protestant Movement.

- **The Priesthood of All believers:**

The Protestant reformers taught that every Christian believer was a “priest” unto God and could approach the throne of God by the blood of Jesus and the grace of God, without the clergy of the church.

- **The Ministry of All Believers:**

This is another way of saying that every believer is a priest unto God. Every Saint has the calling, privilege, and power to minister the Holy Spirit, the Word of God, and the graces of God to others. Every local church should be a congregation of ministers.

- **All Ministers Require the Same Things:**

One can better understand and accept this truth by asking the following questions.

- What does a Saint called to minister in the pulpit need that is different from what a Saint called to minister in the marketplace or other ministries within the local church? Nothing!
- Likewise, every Saint participates in the biblical attributes according to individual calling and membership (as part of the Body of Christ) ministry.

- **Divine Church Structure Will Remain:**

The Saints must understand that the Day of the Saints will not release them to become a law unto themselves. God does everything in divine order. A proper foundation has to be laid before a building can be built. God is restoring the foundational ministries of the apostle and prophet before He fully builds the building of matured and activated Saints.

Saints are saved to god’s purpose

- Why Human Beings Are Called to Be Saints:

- Men and women that brings liberation and freedom to humanity through the power of God
- People that will disarm the powers of wickedness, and bring humanity out of the clutches of corruption into the glory, light and freedom of God
- People whose conduct will be as God himself on the earth, because of their knowledge of their godly nature
- Sonship is the releasing of the life (zoë) of God in people

But the saints of the Most High shall take the kingdom and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.

Until the Ancient of Days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the Most High. And the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

And the kingdom and ruler ship, and the greatness of the kingdom under all the heavens, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. And all kingdoms shall serve and obey Him.

Daniel 7:18, 22, 27
