



THE CIRCLE II CREATE A MOVEMENT

In the Circle of Life, here in Creation we move to a rhythm that is coupled to a distinctive frequency! Once we tune into the correct frequency, we start moving to the rhythm. At that point in time **God accelerates us into His Autobahn**, where everything moves with *unlimited* speeds and we achieve the *unseen, unlimited, unprecedented!*

Matthew 6:9-13

Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Matthew 6:10

1. Connected to the body

As the Body of Christ we need to start working together as God's people in harmony of vision and purpose. It requires a *corporate body* and a *corporate anointing*.

Jesus on earth accomplished this by Himself because in Him dwelled the fullness of the Godhead bodily. The fullness of God was present in the physical body of Jesus. Whatever the Father desired in heaven, Jesus carried out on earth.

For in Him the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature].

Colossians 2:9

It is different with us.

Even though we carry the image and likeness of God (**Gen 1:26,27**), and His Spirit dwells in us, the fullness of God does not reside in us. That was unique to Jesus. We have power and authority, but not to the level Jesus did. He is the **Head**, we are the **body**. The body needs to execute what the Head demands.

The corporate body:

Now you [collectively] are Christ's body and individually you are members of it, each part severally and distinct [each with his ownplace and function].

I Corinthians 12:27

What Jesus managed to do on His own, we need to do as the body.

2. Influence through culture (Kingdom Culture)

Define Kingdom:

- Heaven is like country (designated area), **ruled** by a **King**.
- **King** is the only appropriate title to describe **God's place** in Heaven, no one voted Him into **power**.
- God rules His Kingdom by **divine right**, by **right of creation**.
- Because God created all things, everything **belongs** to Him. He alone is the **rightful Ruler** of the universe.

God's **original intent** was to extend His invisible heavenly kingdom to the earth to influence earth from heaven through the rule of His earthly children created in His image. Man was created as an **extension** of God himself in the earth, to govern and to be fruitful.

**Let Us make man in Our image, in Our likeness, and let them rule...
... be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it.**

Genesis 1:26, 27

In other words, we are His **delegated authority** on earth, to exercise dominion. **Psalm 115:16** says: **The highest heavens belong to the Lord, but the earth He has given to man.**

We all know what happened in Eden! The rule and authority of earth was given over to Satan by Adam. Jesus came back to restore the kingdom to its original place.

The **life, burial and resurrection** of Christ Jesus **concluded** the **restoration** process!

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law that we might receive adoption as sons.

Galatians 4:4-5

As sons of the King our will should be the will of the Father. **Christ** taught us to **pray** and bring this to fruition:

Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Matthew 6:10

What are the main characteristics of this heavenly Kingdom? I.e God's kingdom on earth:

- It has territory
- Common language
- Shared the laws of heaven
- Same moral code
- Common values (customs and social norms)

All the characteristics together display a culture (culmination of elements)

The Holy Spirit is placed here as the **Governor** of our lives. (A **governor** creates boundaries where-in we can operate.) The Holy Spirit is the one who **reveals** to us the will and the ways of the King and **teaches** us how to live a Kingdom lifestyle and manifest Kingdom culture.

Remember that a kingdom is by all means not a democracy. The King's words become policy and constitution. Therefore God has chosen one member of the trinity to be the **Governor**. That is the **Holy Spirit**. He knows the hearts' desire of the Father and will communicate His will and purpose with accuracy.

How are we supposed to connect heaven with earth?

- **Take time to get to know the Governor**

If we are governed by the Holy Spirit it surely means that we have to have a living relationship with Him. That implies that we will know His voice when He speaks to us, but also that we will listen and obey when He speaks. This only happens when we **spend time in His presence**.

We cultivate a healthy relationship with Him through ultimately putting Him at the **center** of our lives.

David says in **Psalm 27:4**:

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that I will seek, inquire for, and [insistently] require: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord [in His presence] all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon the beauty [the sweet attractiveness and the delightful loveliness] of the Lord and to meditate, consider, and inquire in His temple.

Redeemer vs Ruler

He has saved us by grace, but we cannot get stuck at the cross, we need to be raised with Him in His resurrection and ultimately **align with His Lordship!**

- **Embrace the power**

Embrace the power at the center!

Jesus said:

... All authority (power of rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.

Matthew 28:18

Just as You have granted Him power and authority over all flesh (all humankind), [now glorify Him] so that He may give eternal life to all whom You have given Him.

And this is eternal life: [it means] to know (to perceive, recognize, become acquainted with, and understand) You, the only true and real God, and to know Him, Jesus as the Christ (the Anointed One, the Messiah), Whom You have sent.

I have glorified You down here on the earth by completing the work that You gave me to do.

John 17:2-4

Our dominion over the earth is **restored** in Christ Jesus!

And by the Holy Spirit we have received power to produce a harvest of fruit. That is, doing the will of the Father in heaven on the earth.

But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8

I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in Me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

John 14:12

Ephesians 1:19- 23 describes it perfectly:

And [so that you can know and understand] what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength,

Which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His [own] right hand in the heavenly [places],

Far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named [above every title that can be conferred], not only in this age and in this world, but also in the age and the world which are to come.

And He has put all things under His feet and has appointed Him the universal and supreme Head of the church [a headship exercised throughout the church],

Which is His body, the fullness of Him Who fills all in all [for in that body lives the full measure of Him who fills everything everywhere with Himself.]

His full measure of ability resides in us. Heaven is backing me up!

Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you.

Luke 10:19

For if because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one, much more surely will those who receive [God's] overflowing grace and the free gift of righteousness, reign as kings in life through the one Man Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:17

- **Start creating!**

How did God create?

Create means it has come from nothing. Make means it was made from something else. (eg. man was made from dust) Everything that was created was created by speaking it into existence!

Then the Lord formed man from dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath or spirit of life, and man became a living being.

Genesis 2:7

“breath” in Greek is *nšâmâ*, [pronounced ne-sama] meaning:

- a puff,
- a wind,
- angry or vital breath,
- divine inspiration, intellect
- inspiration, soul, spirit
- another speaking spirit

The best way to accurately create is by the Word of God. It will be according to the will of God the Father.

And they were amazed at His teaching, for His word was with authority and ability and weight and power.

Luke 4:32

What is the best way to get started today?

1. **Align with the Lordship of Jesus**
2. **Take time to know the Governor**
3. **Embrace and use the power of authority**
4. **Allow the Creative Force to create through you**

There is FREEDOM in OBEDIENCE!

Obedience practiced brings Authority.
