Four Pillars of An Apostolic House

1. Apostolic Doctrine
2. Fellowship
3. Breaking of Bread
4. Prayer

The four pillars need to be established in perfect balance - the roof cannot be held by uneven pillars.

The SAINTS are being prepared by the FIVE FOLD GRACES to:

- build up the BRIDE OF CHRIST (the Body)- as ONE
- in the pattern of CHRIST (full and accurate knowledge of the Son of God)
- to arrive to mature manhood (the perfect Bride)
- nothing less than the standard height of Christ's own perfection

Synergy : Saints and Five fold (saints)

We Need Power

Ephesians 3:16 (Amplified)

Acts 1:8 (Amplified)

We have been granted power from His glory by the Holy Spirit.

1. First step: Maintenance
2. Second step: From glory to glory

How?

James 5: 13-18 (Amplified)

...The earnest heartfelt continued prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available dynamic in its working...

In the glory of God there is a deeper realm of power available to us **the only way to attain more power is by Prayer.**

Revelation 5:8; 8:3-6 (Amplified)

The prayers of all saints have 2 assignments:

1. Establish God's Kingdom on earth
 - "on earth as it is in heaven"
 - Soteria: A House of Prayer: AS ONE; IN ONE ACCORD
 - Zechariah 12:10
 - Isaiah 56:7,10; Mark 11:17
2. Communion (relationship with the Father as a son)
 - praise, thanksgiving, worship and adoration
 - repentance
 - petition

The prayers of all saints have 2 levels:

Matthew 6:6-13 : The Pattern of Jesus (with your understanding or intellect)

After the CROSS Jesus sent the Holy Spirit (praying by/in the Spirit: in tongues; prophetic prayer)

John 16:7
