## JESUS IS THE SEED

***And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.***

**Genesis 3:15 (NKJV)**

***The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.***

**Matthew 1:1 (KJV)**

- Jesus Christ is the Seed of the woman, (pain)
- The Seed of Abraham (promise)
- And the Seed of David (royalty)

Jesus the Seed, is the sum total, the “Alpha and Omega” of everything that the Father ever wanted to say to us. He is the Logos, the Word, the complete discourse of God to man.

***For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.***

**Romans 8:29 (KJV)**

***I tell you the truth, unless a kernel (SEED) of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.***

**John 12:24 (NIV)**

His resurrection has produced a mighty harvest, His glorious church. The seed of God is His sons and daughters and they are spread throughout the nations.

# Paul wrote to the church at Corinth, He found “Christ” as “the image of God.”

***In whom the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving ones, so that the light of the glorious gospel of Christ (who is the image of God) should not dawn on them.***

**2 Corinthians 4:4 (MKJV)**

The manifestation of Jesus’ present rule and reign is the ultimate intention and expectation of the Father.

That manifestation is in a vast family of sons, conformed to the image of the firstborn, a corporate expression of Jesus’ life and nature. Paul calls this experience “Christ in you”.

***To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.***

**Colossians 1:27 (KJV)**

***And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.***

**Galatians 4:6 (KJV)**

Individually and corporately, we Christians have become the ongoing incarnation of God in the earth!

Adam was the federal head of a natural race. Jesus is the federal head of a spiritual people, who have been regenerated or born from above. (**John 3:7**)

## **The story of the seed**

**In the volume of the Book, it is written of Him.**

- From Genesis to Malachi, the seed comes (**Gen 3:15**).

- In the four Gospels, the seed dies (**John 2:24**).
- In the Book of Acts, the seed lives (**Acts 2:24**).
- From Romans to Jude, the seed speaks (**Heb 1:1**).
- In the Book of Revelation, the seed reigns (**Rev 11:15**).

Isaiah prophesies that Messiah would “see His seed” and they would “prolong His day” (**Isa 53:10**).

## This seed is the word of the kingdom

*When anyone hears the Word of the kingdom and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and catches away that which was sown in his heart. This is the seed sown by the wayside.*

**Matthew 13:19 (MKJV)**

*He put out another parable to them, saying, the kingdom of heaven is compared to a man who sowed good seed in his field.*

**Matthew 13:24 (KJV)**

*And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground.*

**Mark 4:26 (KJV)**

**God is doing only 2 things:**

- Establishing His Kingdom (seed)
- Building His Temple (seed)

*And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the prophets, from morning till evening.*

**Acts 28:23 (KJV)**

## This new season

Nothing will be released in the earth until God’s Saints stands up and declare the Word of the Lord. The sons of God must create and adjudicate the eternal design and desire of their Father.

*As surely as God is trustworthy and faithful and means what He says, our speech and message to you have not been Yes [that might mean] No.*

*For the Son of God, Christ Jesus (the Messiah), Who has been preached among you by us, by myself, Silvanus, and Timothy, was not Yes and No; but in Him it is [always the divine] Yes.*

*For as many as are the promises of God, they all find their Yes [answer] in Him [Christ]. For this reason we also utter the Amen (so be it) Emuwn (ay-moon) = Established, trusty, trustworthiness. Aman (aw-man) = Confirmed, established, sure, reliable, certain - to God through Him [in His Person and by His agency] to the glory of God.*

**2 Corinthians 1:18-20 (AMP)**

**In this ever-changing cosmos, three things never change:**

1. The person who called you (**Heb. 13:8**).
2. The promise that thrilled you (**1 Kings 8:56**).
3. The power which will enable you to finish your course with joy (**Ps. 138:8; Jer. 29:11; Phil. 1:6**).

*But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.*

**Hebrews 11:6**

The Tabernacle of Moses is a divine “pattern” (**Ex. 25:40**). The Outer Court (which corresponds to the Feast of Passover) is all about man. The Holy Place (the Feast of Pentecost) is a mixture of God and man. Within the Most Holy place (the Feast of Tabernacles), the realm of His finished work, the world of worship, is all about God.

*And all of these, though they won divine approval by [means of] their faith, did not receive the fulfilment of what was promised, because God had us in mind and had something better and greater in view for us, so that they [these heroes and heroines of faith] should not come to perfection apart from us [before we could join them].*

**Hebrews 11:39-40 (AMP)**

***THEREFORE THEN, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who have borne testimony to the Truth], let us strip off and throw aside every encumbrance (unnecessary weight) and that sin which so readily (deftly and cleverly) clings to and entangles us, and let us run with patient endurance and steady and active persistence the appointed course of the race that is set before us, looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. He, for the joy [of obtaining the prize] that was set before Him, endured the cross, despising and ignoring the shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God.***

**Hebrews 12:1-2 (AMP)**

- The kind of faith revealed through the lives of each famous man or woman mentioned in **Hebrews 11** exemplifies our faith in God.
- The margin of **Mark 11:22** urges, “Have the faith of God”.
- The greater dimension of faith revealed in **Hebrews 12**, the faith of Jesus, is “the faith of God”.

God is about to do something in the earth so incredible awesome that He is the only one who can believe for it.

More than that, God is the only one who can empower His people to walk into what only He can believe for!
